# Key Stage 4 (Years 9, 10 & 11) Uniform Expectations

# **Mandatory Items of Uniform**

- Scott College Blazer
- College Tie Logo Showing below the knot.
- Scott College Jumper Jumpers may not be worn in replacement of a blazer.
- Black Smart Business-like Trousers Not skin tight No Leggings or Jeans
  - Trousers should reach the tops of the shoe.
- Scott College Skirt Knee length
  - Pleated Scott College skirts must not be rolled at the waist.
- White shirt
- Black leather shoes Not Trainers (See below)
- Plain black ankle length socks (not trainer/pop socks) no logo
- Plain black socks worn below the knee
- Black Belt Only only on items with belt loops.
- Plain Black or skin coloured tights may be worn.

Additional clothing should not be visible under uniform (e.g. long sleeved or high necked top).

## Shoes


Shoes should be flat, black, polishable, and made of leather or vegan alternatives.


Students should not wear boots, suede or cloth shoes.

Students will not be allowed into lesson in incorrect footwear.

If a student wears incorrect shoes they will be expected to wear replacement shoes provided by the college until resolved. If students don't wish to wear replacement shoes, they will be asked to remain in the AR room until the issue can be resolved.

### **Jumpers**

Scott College has a specially designed raglan sleeved jumper available from the uniform shop. **Only** this jumper is available to wear as part of the Scott College Key Stage 4 Uniform. Jumpers should not be worn tucked in.

### Hair and Makeup

Coats should not be worn once inside the college building.

Hair bands must be plain and only black in colour (no other hair accessories should be worn).

Hairstyle and colour must be natural. Non Natural colour dyed hair (blue, scarlett, green, purple, pink, orange etc) must not be worn. Students will not be welcome to stay in college until the colour returns to a natural hair colour.

Clipper cut hair must be no shorter than grade 2.

### Make-up/ Nails

Students are being prepared for careers in medicine and healthcare where very stringent personal care must be taken to prevent infection or harming patients. We have consulted with our partners about the guidelines used within the NHS and have adapted them for our setting as can be seen below.

Only natural, light make up is allowed. Students wearing excessively coloured or heavy make-up will be asked to remove it prior to going to lessons. This includes all false nails, eyelashes and coloured nail varnish. Students will be asked to remove false nails, eye lashes and nail varnish.

### Jewelry/ Piercings

No items of jewellery are allowed except a standard wrist watch and one pair of studs worn in the ear lobe.

Students will not be allowed to cover other piercings with a plaster or wear any form of bar or hoop at college. The college accepts no responsibility for any financial issues or risk of infection that arises if students are asked to remove piercings.

Students will be encouraged to wear School Awarded lapel on the blazer lapels. Charity lapel badges may be worn with the consent of the students' Head of Year.

Year 9, 10 and 11 Scott College Students must wear correct uniform when attending college and for all college functions unless instructed otherwise.
