New School Meal Price from April 22

Dear Parents

I write to inform you that from April 2022 there will be a 25p price increase in the cost of a main meal from £2.50 to £2.75 for paying students. We have increased the allowance to £2.75 for those who are free school meals in order to cover this price increase.

For many years, meal price increases have been minimal but unfortunately due to the global climate and the increase across all areas we have had to increase accordingly. Our new menus now include British Red Tractor Meat, sustainably sourced fish and local produce where possible from a sustainable source and continues to meet the government school food based standard. It is important to note that school meals remain very competitive compared to other schools/colleges locally.

Our catering team, as always, remains committed to providing a quality service and healthy meal to your child at lunch-time and we will continue to work with the college community to ensure we achieve this.

We continue to offer a free breakfast to all students each day from 7.45am which consists of healthy porridge; buttered bagel; toast and a range of cereals. Students can purchase breakfast wraps, bacon bap, egg muffin, cheese on toast and cereal bars during this time. Our menu is available on the website and you will see it offers a diverse range of options and of course your child can bring a packed lunch should the canteen not be appropriate for your child.

We continue to advise all students to bring in water bottles that can be refilled from the refill stations that are positioned throughout the school.
