Mobile Phones

These devices are not banned from school as we recognise that they may be needed for the journey to and from school each day. Having arrived on the school premises however, all phones will need to be switched off and kept out of sight in the student's school bag (not in a pocket), together with any headphones.

If a phone is seen during lesson time or around the school, it will be confiscated and parents/carers will be asked to collect it from the main school reception at the end of the day. · The same applies to headphones. Headphones are not to be worn around the neck. They should be placed in bags during the school day.

If a student refuses to hand their phone or headphones over, they will be sent to the AR room for a period of one working day. Refusal to go to the AR will result in an extended period in the AR and a parental meeting.
