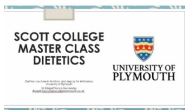

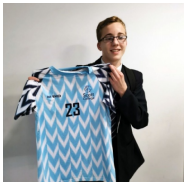

## **DR.EAM Dentistry Conference**

The DR.EAM Dentistry Conference is for Year 10 to 13 students in the UK who are considering a career in dentistry and is a free, virtual conference hosted by Birmingham Widening Access to Medical Sciences society (BWAMS).

The conference will provide students with an insight into life as both a dental student and dentist, as well as advising on next steps to prepare for an application. The day will consist of inspiring talks, workshops and panels made up of dentists and dental students from around the country. Workshops will include an introduction to clinical skills, Q&A with dental students from different universities and work experience advice.

Widening Access at the Medical School will be helping in the selection of students according to the University's widening access selection criteria, with priority given to pupils from areas with a low number of students attending University for this event.
