Year 9 Options Process and Parents' Evening

Throughout Year 9, your child has followed an introductory curriculum to prepare them for Key Stage 4; designed to cover key content in core subjects, as well as preparatory work in courses such as Health and Social Care, Psychology and Sport & Fitness. Students follow this pathway to ensure they feel fully informed before making their final choices for study throughout Years 10 and 11.

All students continue to study Core Subjects; English Literature and Language, Maths, Statistics, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Core PE and PSE. Alongside these subjects students will study three options, choosing one EBacc subject and two from our Open offer (as detailed below):

Step 3: Select Booking Mode

Step 6: Book Appointments (Automatic)

If you chose the automatic booking mode, you'll see provisional appointments which are held for 2 minutes. To keep them, choose *Accept* at the bottom left.

If it wasn't possible to book every selected teacher during the times you are able to attend, you can either adjust the teachers you wish to meet with and try again, or switch to manual booking mode.

Step 7: Book Appointments

Click any of the green cells to make an appointment. Blue cells signify where you already have an appointment. Grey cells are unavailable.

To change an appointment, delete the original by hovering over the blue box and clicking *Delete*. Then choose an alternate time.

You can optionally leave a message for the teacher to say what you'd like to discuss, or raise anything beforehand.

Once you're finished booking all appointments, at the top of the page in the alert box, press *click here* to finish the booking process.
