Re: Exit programme for students

As we approach the end of the exam year, we believe it is crucial to provide our students with dedicated time for focused study and preparation for their final examinations. In order to help maximise the time in school we continue to provide booster sessions for each subject the day before the exam. We want all students to follow this timetable and be in school on the times specified. There are some slots where students have the option of studying at school or they can go home to study. Our dedicated team of teachers and support staff will continue to be available to provide remote guidance and assistance. Students can reach out to their teachers via email to seek clarification or address any concerns they may have. If students choose to remain in school for these independent study slots, they will have access to the supervised study space. The programme for the week beginning 9th June will be shared with yourselves and the students by the end of this week.

If your child chooses in these slots to work from home we kindly request your support and cooperation in ensuring that your child has a conducive learning environment at home, and not choose to waste this time out and about in the community. They are nearly finished so let's ensure that they remain focused on their work right to the final exam. We trust you to guide and motivate your child throughout this period. Your involvement and encouragement will undoubtedly have a positive impact on their academic performance.

Students should be spending the May Half Term revising for their post break exams. - **Arrival Time:** SMHC will have their revision sessions in SDCC due to building works taking place so students must arrive promptly for AM session or PM session, and report to SDCC Main Reception for registration. 10am-12pm for the morning session and 12.30pm-2.30pm for the afternoon session. Lunch will be provided on Tuesday and will also be provided for those students who choose to sign up to a private study session on Wednesday or Thursday.

The final decision about those pupils at risk attending the prom will be made by Mr Gill immediately after the last exam.*

Year 11 GCSE Results Day – Thursday 20th August 2026

Pupils must collect their results in person. However, if they would like us to give their results to a parent or other family member, the pupil must give them a signed letter giving their permission.
